Zone 1 North West Preston	Highways and Transport Hubs	Broughton Bypass	The IDPB was asked to approve and endorse the procurement process of the engineering contract. The Procurement Strategy was approved previously by the IDPB, though not recorded in the minutes. This strategy sets out the various options available and in particular considered the benefits of in-house delivery compared to procuring construction through a competitive tender exercise. It was agreed that the construction works for Broughton By-Pass are procured through a competitive tender exercise under the provisions of the ECC Option A contract (please see Action Notes- Item 3.1). Chair – Approved, subject to sight of the Procurement Strategy.



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			Action: Procurement Strategy to be forwarded to Chair (MG) Action: The CPO decision which is needed for a full Business Case, has not yet been received from the Secretary of State, if still outstanding by end of July, then JT to prompt a decision as land to be acquired by end of December.
			 IDPB endorsed: Planning Application to discharge conditions in order to go to tender Tender to proceed (14/07/15) in advance of any decision with a small risk of an unsatisfactory decision
Zone 1 North West Preston	Highways and Transport Hubs	Preston Western Distributor	Action: Report to be compiled regarding the Railway Canal Crossing including costs (PW). Both options including recommendations to be put before the next IDPB (PW).
			Action: Early Contractor Involvement report for next IDPB, if favourable outcome is confirmed by Julia Johnson (PW).
Zone 1 North West Preston	Highways and Transport Hubs	East West Link Road	Action: Verbal narrative to be given to the City Deal Executive regarding the opportunity to join both the PWD and EWLR Planning Applications together as there is considerable pressure to deliver these projects at the earliest opportunity. This will allow the timescales to be moved forward, representing a change in the IDP milestones (PW).
			Tabley Lane Action: Meeting to be arranged in connection with change to an adopted line at Tabley Lane, to discuss the approach to take and highlight any risk management issues (PW).
			Legal advice is to be sought in relation to the potential for enhanced value and financial clawback position on land off Lightfoot Lane (easterly end of East-West Link Road. This will be a joint instruction between LCC, PCC and HCA.
			Action: JT to be given full details and to explore CPO and property entitlements to suggest options for LCC as highway authority to proceed to acquire title or rights to construct public highway on this land(MH.)
			Action: Report to be prepared on land acquisition (MH).
			Action: Determine the "enhanced value" in relation to the clawback issue (MH).
